ELECTRONIC CIGARETTE

The Cold Turkey e cigarette is comprised of three main parts, the battery, the atomizer (heating element), and the cartridge (mouthpiece).

The function of the battery is to provide operational power to the e cigarette, it is controlled by an intelligent microchip providing cutoff, and overcharging protection.

The function of the atomizer is to heat the liquid and convert it into a fine mist of water vapor that can be inhaled.

The function of the cartridge is to store liquid in a polyester mesh to provide a constant supply of liquid to the atomizer as well as to serve as a mouthpiece through which the user can inhale the vapor.

Chargers that are powered from an automobile or boat cigarette lighter

GETTING STARTED

Remove the new atomizer from its box, remove the plastic cartridge (mouthpiece) from the atomizer and discard, as it is a blank used as a protective cover only, it has no polyester mesh inside. Screw the atomizer on to the battery. Remove a new cartridge from its box, wrapper, and rubber cover. If your kit comes with pre filled cartridges, no initial cartridge filling is necessary. If your kit comes with empty cartridges, slowly drip liquid into the polyester mesh, you will notice the liquid soaking into the polyester mesh, slowly repeat drops until the polyester remains moist and will not soak any more liquid. This can take from 8 to 12 drops for a small cartridge and up to 40 drops for a large cartridge. One or two drops can also be added directly into the large opening of the atomizer to jump start it.

PRECAUTIONS

Only the dedicated components must be used, and the proper operation procedures must be followed to prevent malfunction and damage of the product. We do not accept warranty claims if you use other operation procedures than the ones stipulated herewith.

Keep the device separated from other articles such as keys and change that will collide with the device.

Keep away from high temperature and/or humid environments. Keep the device and its components out of children's reach, and avoid improper operation.

ACCESSORIES

Many accessories may be available for your electronic cigarette:

After all filling is complete, insert the filled cartridge fully into the atomizer.

USING YOUR E CIGARETTE

Once your e cigarette is charged and assembled you may begin use. Press and hold the button as you slowly inhale for no more than five seconds to prevent overheating. Exhale after one or two seconds. Repeat this as needed. Some users inhale into their mouth for a few seconds and then all at once, do a lung inhale while others inhale directly into their lungs. This is a matter of user preference. If your e cigarette is an automatic type, you will not need to press a button as it has an internal pressure switch to detect your inhaled.

CHARGING THE BATTERY

When your battery becomes depleted, the led light will flash several times letting you know it

needs to be recharged. To recharge the battery, disassemble the battery from the atomizer and screw it into the charger, the light on the battery will flash signaling that it is connected to the charger. A dead battery will indicate a red light on the charger. When the battery is fully charged, the charger light will be solid blue or green, depending on the type of charger. Charging time is normally 1 to 2 hours.

WARNINGS

Only charge the batteries with the charger specifically designed for your model. Otherwise, the battery can be damaged or can explode. For your safety make sure that you do not leave the battery unattended while it is recharging. In the case that a problem should arise with this product, please go to your retailer/seller, and do not try to dismantle the e cigarette by yourself.
